

Every one of them told her it was a bad idea and signified medical failure, so she pushed the idea to the back of her mind. She married her college sweetheart and within a decade they had four children. By the time her youngest was a toddler, the Internet had grown enough to give her new answers. Answers that included hope. On a cold winter day she walked into a hospital on two feet and hopped out a day later with just one. She has never looked back....
